

At 61 feet wide with 50-inch deep drapers, this is the highest capacity FlexDraper MacDon has ever produced. Compared to our 50-foot FD250, the FD261 gives you an additional 22% of overall capacity.

What's the Same?

Except for a few minor differences, the FD261 is basically the same as all other sizes of the FD2 FlexDraper, with the performance advantage of a 61-foot configuration.

If you're already running an FD2, the FD261 uses common parts that work on all FD2 models.

What's Different?

There are two differences in Performance Options with the FD261. First, MacDon's EasyMove Transport is unavailable on the FD261, so a trailer is the only option to haul this unit. Second, the Stubble Lights package comes with four lights instead of two; more stubble, more lights.

The biggest differences on the FD261 are on the performance side: It has more total flex range, more ground coverage, and more capacity to feed the growing appetites of today's modern combines.

The FD261 boasts an impressive overall Flex Range with over 46 inches of total wing range on either end of the header, completely independent of the combine.
